SUBJECT: Award Road Base for OHV Grant Project

RECOMMENDATION: Award road base (Caltrans Class 2 Aggregate (3/4") or NDOT Type 1 Class A or NDOT Type 1 Class B) to Hat Creek Construction, Inc. to the lowest bidder meeting specifications in in the amount of \$171,250.00 plus an additional contingency of 20% (\$34,250) for a total not to exceed amount of \$205,500.00.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Formal bidding procedures were completed with a bid opening on May 15, 2025. The bids were as follows:

Sierra Cascade Aggregate, Chester, CA \$36.50/ton (estimated quantity 5,000 tons)

Hat Creek Construction, Inc., Burney, CA \$34.50/ton (estimated quantity 5,000 tons)

All bids are responsive and meet the specifications. It is recommended that the award be made to Hat Creek Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$171,250.00 plus an additional contingency of 20% (\$34,250) for a total not to exceed amount of \$205,500.00.

This project is estimated to complete 2.25 miles of road hardening along Hackstaff Road and Fort Sage. This grant has to be used on roads that are associated with "Green Sticker" vehicles. The County is required to match 26% of the project which will be the cost of equipment and labor to spread the aggregate.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: Funding is available in Road Operating Budget, Fund 122-1221.
