RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND PROVIDING TO CALPERS PUBLICLY AVAILABLE PAY SCHEDULES (PAPS) INCREASING PAY RATES BY 3.1%, EFFECTIVE JULY 5, 2026, FOR APPOINTED DEPARTMENT HEADS-CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES-ELECTED OFFICIALS, MANAGEMENT AND PROFESSIONALS ASSOCIATION, PEACE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION, PEACE OFFICERS MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION, ROAD WORKERS ASSOCIATION AND LASSEN COUNTY GENERAL UNIT-UPEC LOCAL 792 TO COMPLY WITH COMPENSATION REPORTING REQUIREMENTS UNDER PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT LAW (PERL), PUBLIC EMPLOYEE'S PENSION REFORM ACT OF 2013 (PEPRA), AND TITLE 2 OF THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS (CCR)

WHEREAS, California Public Employees Retirement System (CalPERS) requires all government agencies to provide a Publicly Available Pay Schedule (PAPS) in compliance with the Public Employees' Retirement Law (PERL), Public Employee's Pension Reform Act of 2013 (PEPRA), and Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR); and

WHEREAS, PAPS are required by CalPERS and are a critical component to verify a members' pay rates when calculating members' retirement benefits. Maintaining a compliant publicly available pay schedule will support transparency and expedite CalPERS' review process; and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Appointed Department Heads-Confidential Employees-Elected Officials by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Management and Professionals Association by Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Peace Officers Association by Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Peace Officers Management Association by Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Road Workers Association by Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

WHEREAS, County has established salaries, benefits and hourly salary schedules for Lassen County General Unit-UPEC Local 792 by Memorandum of Understanding (MOU); and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lassen that the Board hereby approves the PAPS and authorizes submittal to CalPERS.
