The student will not receive a refund after more than 60% of the instruction has been presented.

If a student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of money not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF)

"The state of California established the student tuition recovery fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic loss suffered by a student in an educational program at a qualifying institution, who is or was California resident while enrolled, or was enrolled in a residency program, if the student enrolled in the institution, prepaid tuition, and suffered an economic loss unless relieved of the obligation to do so, you must pay the state-imposed assessment for the STRF, or it must be paid on your behalf, if you are a student in an educational program, who is a California resident, or are enrolled in a residency program, and prepaid all or part of your tuition. You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment, if you are not a California resident, or not enrolled in a residency program."

If the student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have the responsibility to pay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund.

If the student defaults on a federal or state loan, both the following may occur:

- The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student, including applying any income tax refund to which the person is entitled to reduce the balance owed n the loan.
- 2. The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid t another institution or other government financial assistance, at another institution until the loan is repaired.

The student may cancel/ withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a prorated refund of the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charges if the student has completed 60% or less of instruction. The student will not receive a refund after more than 60% of the instruction has been presented. The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of days or hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

No refunds are due once the student has received 60% of the clock hours of instruction in any given period of attendance. For purposes of determining a refund, a student shall be considered to have withdrawn from an educational program when they withdraw or is deemed withdrawn in accordance with the withdrawal policy stated in this institution's catalog.

If an institution has collected money from a student for transmittal on the student's behalf to a third party for a bond, library usage, or fees for a license, application, or examination and the institution has not paid the money to the third party at the time of the student's withdrawal or cancellation, the institution shall refund the money to the student within 45 days of the student's withdrawal or cancellation.

- Tests must be completed NO EARLIER than 30 days before your first scheduled class date.
- You must have a permit to schedule a drug test.
- Test results take 3-5 days to return so please plan accordingly.
- If you had a urine sample collected at your DOT physical appointment, it was most likely NOT a drug test.

Important Information About Your Class

If you don't have a permit yet, please work on obtaining one ASAP. The sooner you have a permit inhand, the sooner we can schedule your behind-the-wheel drive test.

• When you have a valid permit in your hands, call the main office at (530) 226-0923 and let us know as soon as possible!

The Schedule

Students spend 20 hours completing 1-on-1 pre-test practice with a personal instructor and 20 hours completing the ELDT theory requirements (bookwork). You will receive a text message the week before your class is set to begin with more information on your start time, meeting location, etc. Please note, this is an hourly based program, and students must attend 100% of their scheduled hours of instruction to pass. If you have a scheduling conflict, contact David at (530) 226-0923 as soon as possible.

- One-Week/ 40-Hour students will be with their instructors for four hours and be in our classroom for four hours with a lunch in-between, each day.
- Hybrid students will complete their bookwork at home using our online training system, then attend a 2.5 day in-person training with a personal instructor.

Hybrid (half online/ half in-person) Students

Although you will be completing the ELDT theory curriculum at home, you are not completely on your own. An instructor will be monitoring your progress periodically and will be available if you have any trouble advancing through the program. There are a few ways to connect with an instructor during your program if you have any questions or complications:

Class "A"/ "B" Pre-Trip and Airbrake study guides are attached. Please print them out to prepare for your class/ exam. If you are studying for your Class "B" Commercial License, please disregard the "trailer" section of the study material.

• It is important you study the attached material prior to your class! If you do not study, your week could possibly be more stressful than it needs to be. Please do not use any other material other than what we have provided for you (YouTube videos will confuse you so beware!)

What to Bring to Class

Please come prepared with the following items:

- Commercial Learner's Permit (this is the most important!)
- · Class "C" Driver's License.
- · DOT Physical packet.
- Snacks, water, lunch, etc.
- · Closed-toed shoes, preferably tennis shoes.
- Weather appropriate clothing (Redding is HOT in the Summer and COLD in the Winter).

Rescheduling

Jiffy's Truck School is the only true one-on-one CDL school in the state (maybe even the country!). When you reserve a seat in a class with us, you are reserving a truck, trailer, and a personal mentor for 5 days. In the event you have a scheduling conflict and need to reschedule your class dates, we ask to be given a 14-day notice as a courtesy to your instructor scheduled to personally work with you, so we can find another driver to fill your seat. With proper notice, we do not charge a "rescheduling fee".

Cancellations/ Refunds

In the event you cannot reschedule your course and need to cancel your reservation entirely, there are non-refundable fees involved. There is automatically a \$250 non-refundable registration fee for anyone enrolled in a 40-hour in-person course OR a hybrid course. If you have paid the rental fee for use of the truck for the DMV behind-the-wheel drive test, that fee is also non-refundable (\$340 for in-person courses during weekdays and \$595 for hybrid courses over the weekend and 4/10 classes). Please note, after a student has started a course (online or in-person), the refund will be prorated. Refunds are processed within 45 days from the time a "notice of withdrawal" is received in writing.

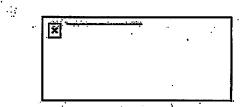

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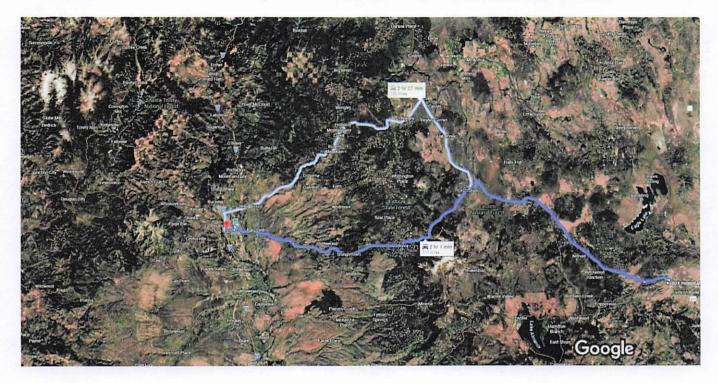

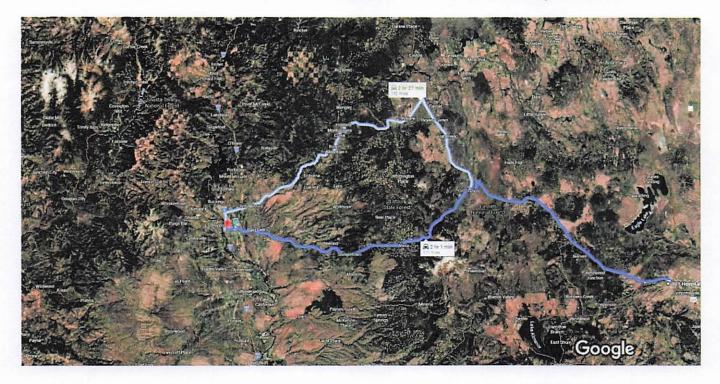
