Subject: Public Hearing for the 2022 State Community Block Grant Program (CDBG) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

# Background:

On April 19, 2022, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) published the 2022 CDBG NOFA. Eligible cities and counties may submit applications for the use of CDBG funds under this NOFA.

CDBG funds are provided as grants for a wide range of activities directed toward economic development, improvement of community facilities and infrastructure, neighborhood revitalization, and public services. All CDBG activities must meet one of the following National Objectives: benefit lowand moderate-income persons; aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight; or meet certain urgent community needs.

Eligible activities in the 2022 CDBG Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) consist of: homeownership assistance and housing rehabilitation programs; public facility and public improvements projects (including public improvements in support of new housing construction); public service programs, planning studies, economic development business assistance and microenterprise activities.

On December 20, 2022, Community Social Services presented on the 2022 CDBG NOFA during a Public Hearing, encouraging the public to provide input on potential project ideas. Lassen County Health and Social Services received a project proposal from the Westwood Area Chamber of Commerce to conduct improvements to the Westwood Community Center.

The County of Lassen has approximately \$307,971 in CDBG Program Income, and Lassen County Health and Social Services is proposing to apply under the 2022 CDBG NOFA to use all of that Program Income to provide needed upgrades to the Westwood Community Center. The funding will be used to complete the required National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) clearances, to procure an architect to complete plans and specifications for improvements and to begin the needed upgrades and improvements. The available Program Income will not cover the cost of all of the needed improvements, and Lassen County Health and Social Services intends to apply for a future CDBG grant to request additional funds.

# Fiscal Impact:

There is no impact to County General Funds. If the application is approved, the project will be funded by the County's CDBG Program Income Trust account (312-0941-7603396).

# Action Requested:

- 1) Adopt resolution; and
- 2) Authorize the County Administrative Officer to execute and deliver the application and act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to the application.

#### **SECTION 6:**

If an application is approved, the (title of designated official) County Administrative Officer, or designee, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Requests and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the grant.

\* <u>Important Note</u>: If the designee is signing any application, agreement, or any other document on behalf of the designated official of the City/County, written proof of designee authority to sign on behalf of such designated official must be included with the Resolution, otherwise the Resolution will be deemed deficient and rejected. Additionally, do not add limitations or conditions on the ability of the signatory or signatories to sign documents, or the Resolution may not be accepted. If more than one party's approval is required, list them as a signatory. The only exception is for county counsel or city attorney to approve as to form or legality or both, IF such approval is already part of the standard city/county signature block as evidenced by the signed Resolution itself. Inclusions of additional limitations or conditions on the authority of the signer will result in the Resolution being rejected and will require your entity to issue a corrected Resolution prior to the Department issuing a Standard Agreement.
