**Subject:** Second Amendment to the Agreement between Lassen County and Restpadd, Inc. to extend the Maximum Contract Amount for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and Fiscal Year 2026/2027.

**Background:**

Lassen County Health and Social Services respectfully requests approval of the Second Amendment to the Agreement between Lassen County Behavioral Health and Restpadd, Inc.

Restpadd, Inc provides acute psychiatric inpatient treatment services for individuals experiencing severe mental health crises who require intensive, hospital-level psychiatric care. These services are essential for individuals whose psychiatric needs cannot be safely or effectively managed in outpatient or community-based settings. Access to acute inpatient treatment ensures that clients receive timely stabilization, comprehensive psychiatric evaluation, medication management, and therapeutic interventions in a safe, secure environment.

Approval of this amendment will ensure that Lassen County Behavioral Health has sufficient funding available to continue providing uninterrupted access to medically necessary acute psychiatric inpatient treatment services for eligible clients. The demand for these services is difficult to predict and is based on clinical necessity rather than predetermined utilization. Increasing the maximum contract amount will enable the County to meet its obligation to provide appropriate levels of behavioral health care while remaining compliant with state and federal requirements for treating individuals experiencing psychiatric emergencies.

Restpadd, Inc. has been a valued provider of specialized inpatient psychiatric services, offering high-quality care that supports client stabilization and recovery. Maintaining this partnership allows Lassen County Behavioral Health to continue meeting the needs of residents who require acute psychiatric hospitalization and to ensure continuity of care during periods of crisis.

**Fiscal Impact:**

This Agreement will be paid from Behavioral Health Fund/Budget No.110/0751.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT ("Amendment") is made by and between Lassen County ("COUNTY") and Restpadd, Inc., with a principal place of business at 2750 Eureka Way, Redding, CA 96001 (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR"), who agree as follows:

1. **Recitals:** This Second Amendment is made with reference to the following facts and objectives:

COUNTY and CONTRACTOR have entered into a written Agreement for the term of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2027, (the "Agreement") in which CONTRACTOR agreed to provide acute psychiatric inpatient care to the residents of Lassen County under the Short-Doyle Act (Welfare and Institutions Code, Sections 5600, et seq.),

2. **Amendments:** The parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

a. The parties desire to extend the Maximum Contract Amount. Therefore, the Attachment B Payment Grid is deleted and replaced with the following:
