SUBJECT: Award Sand for Chip Seal Project

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Award sand (chip seal fine aggregate ¼" max, per section 37 of Caltrans Standard Specification 2022) to Sierra Cascade Aggregate and Asphalt Products, Inc. in the amount of \$30,459.00, the lowest bidder meeting specifications.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Formal bidding procedures were completed for sand with a bid opening on January 25, 2025. The bids were as follows:

Dan Palmer Trucking, Inc., Anderson, CA \$55.99/ton (estimated quantity 710 tons)

Larranaga Trucking, Inc., Alturas, CA \$45/ton (estimated quantity 710 tons)

Iron Response, LLC, Meadow Vista, CA \$55.35/ton (estimated quantity 710 tons)

Sierra Cascade Aggregate, Chester, CA \$40/ton (estimated quantity 710 tons)

Hat Creek Construction, Inc., Burney, CA \$62/ton (estimated quantity 710 tons)

All bid are responsive and meet the specifications. It is recommended that the award be made to Sierra Cascade Aggregate and Asphalt Products Inc. in the amount of \$30,459.00.

This project is estimated to complete 18.3 miles of chip seals on Termo/Grasshopper Road (CR513).
