Re: Lassen County Fair Building reduced Fee Request by Lassen Youth Wrestling Association

Recommendation: That the Board consider selecting one of the following options:

- 1) Charge the standard fee in the amount of \$200 per day (\$16,000 per season)
- 2) Charge a reduced fee in the amount of \$20 per day (\$1,600 per season)
- 3) Wave all fees.

The program provides a safe, structured, and supportive environment where youth can build physical strength and learn mental fortitude.
