Historic Lassen County Jail

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board: Adopt Resolution

PRIOR BOARD ACTIONS: None.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: State grant funding from the State of California Rural Recreation and Tourism Program is available to create new tourism and recreation opportunities. This funding can be used to provide structural stabilization of historic Lassen County Jail to develop it into a "new" historic site. The jail was built in 1911 and condemned in 1971. The building over time is collapsing upon itself. Long-term weathering and cracking of the unreinforced masonry walls and inclement weather has destroyed a sizable portion of the exterior walls and roof. Addressing the deterioration of the building is requiring fencing the site and will require a combination of selective dismantling, demolition or stabilization overtime.

The proposed resolution, if approved by the Board, will authorize county staff to prepare and submit an application seeking up to \$3 million dollars to address the building's structural condition. Grant funds would be used to save the historic character of the jail by stabilizing the structure as much as feasible. In addition, grant funds would be used to present information about the history of the site, including the historic courthouse, and provide directions and information to visitors about other historical sites and recreation trails. Information would be presented in interpretive displays in a central gathering place outside the jail. The grant would also provide for converting the dirt lot behind the jail (former new-old jail location) into visitor parking.

If the County's grant application is approved by the State, then final review and approval of the project and grant-agreement would be considered by the Board of Supervisors.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: To be determined, annually. This tourism grant agreement, if awarded, will include a 30-year deed restriction requiring the County to ensure operation and maintenance of the project site for 30 years.

- 3. Certifies that the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and
- 4. Delegates the authority to the County Administrative Officer or his/her designee to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope; and
- 5. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.
- 6. Will consider promoting inclusion per Public Resources Code §80001(b)(8 A-G).
