The CCVAA training is scheduled for September 12-16, 2022 in San Diego, CA. The conference and training are grant funded and approved with the 2021/2022 Victim/ Witness grant through Cal OES.

The Victim/Witness grant is reimbursed to the county as previously approved for the 2021/2022 grant fiscal year (grant fiscal year ends September 30, 2022). The total travel cost is \$4,690.99: \$2,189.65 for the CDAA Conference and \$2,501.34 for the CCVAA Entry Level Training.
