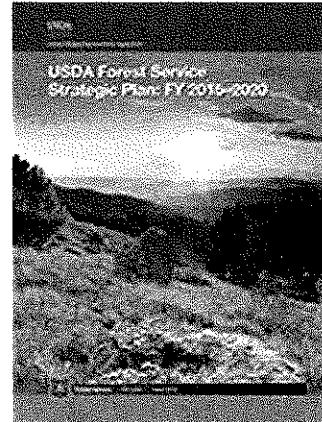

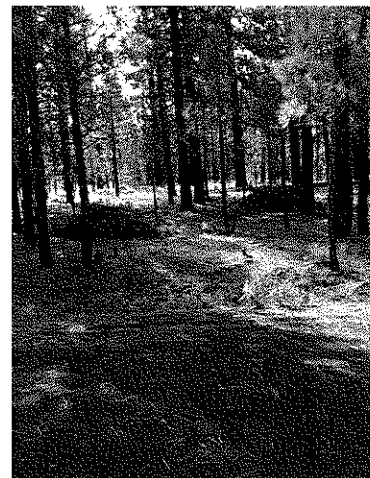

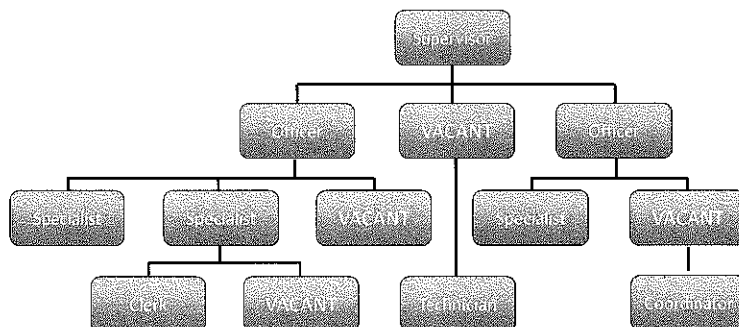
- Fire salvage and restoration efforts

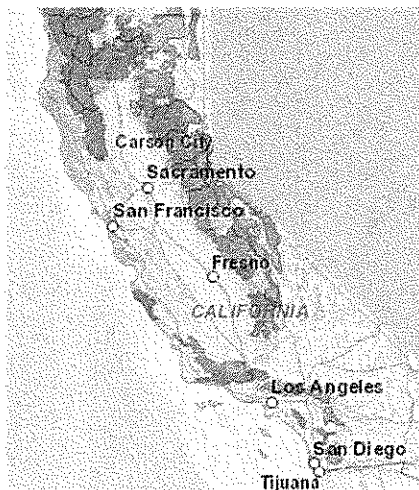

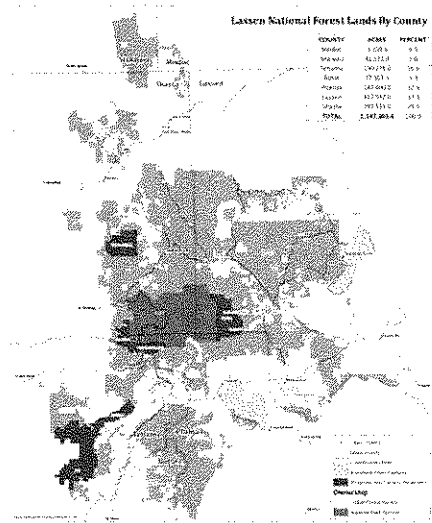

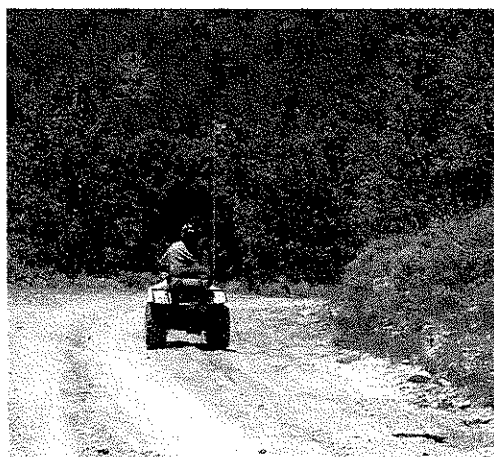

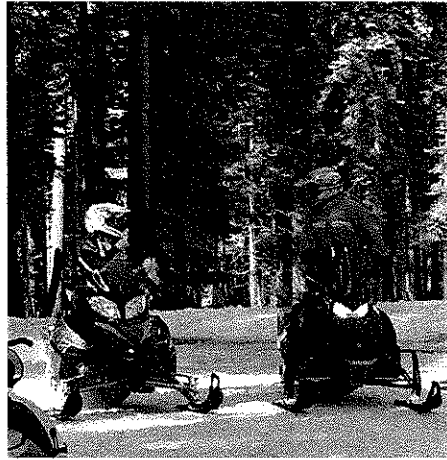

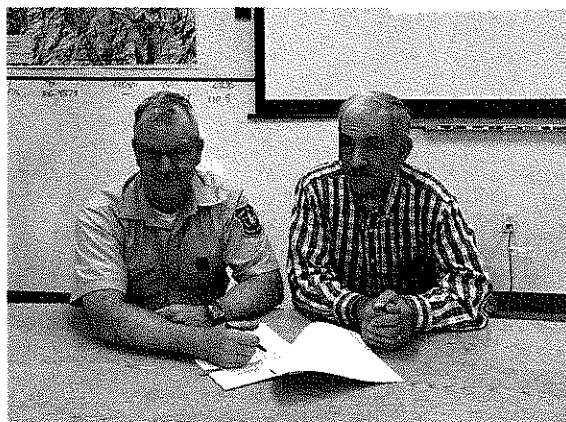
