Dear Board Members:

This is to inform you that on Saturday, September 9, 2017, at approximately 1655 hours, approximately 1 quart of power steering fluid was spilled into an irrigation channel, on the east side of Old Town Road, approximately 4.9 miles south of Finland Drive. The spill was a result of a solo vehicle traffic collision, involving a 2007 Ford F-350 pickup. The cleanup efforts were coordinated by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, with the assistance of Cal-Fire. The cleanup was completed on September 9, 2017.

This report is submitted pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 25180.7 (Proposition 65). The report documents information regarding the discharge of hazardous material which could cause substantial injury to the public health or safety. The report is submitted on behalf of all designated employees of the Department of the California Highway Patrol.

1 SEQUENCE OF EVENTS:

2 On September 9, 2017, at approximately 1655 hours, a 2007 Ford F-350 was being driven by Carl
3 Anthony McCain. Mr. McCain was traveling southbound on Old Town Road, south of Finland
4 Drive, at approximately 25 to 30 MPH. At this location, Old Town Road is a private dirt road that
5 traverses property owned by W.M. Beaty and Associates. The roadway is bordered on the east
6 and west by open fields. Due to his state of intoxication, Mr. McCain allowed the Ford to veer left
7 and leave the roadway. After leaving the roadway, the front axle of the Ford became high
8 centered on the east edge of a cattle grate that crosses the roadway at this location. The impact
9 caused a leakage of approximately 1 quart of the Ford's power steering fluid. The power steering
10 fluid dripped into an irrigation channel on the east side of the cattle grate. Upon their arrival,
11 personnel from Cal-Fire placed a floating dam and absorbent pads into the irrigation channel.
12 The Ford was later towed from the scene by Lake Almanor Towing. The property Manager, Ryan
13 Hilburn was contacted at the scene and was notified of the incident.

1 CLEANUP ACTIONS:

2 Cleanup consisted of the use of a floating dam and absorbent pads that were placed on the
3 surface of the water by Cal-Fire personnel. After evaluating the circumstances of the incident,
4 California Department of Fish and Game Warden Ryan Thiem declared the scene safe at
5 approximately 2050 hours.
