

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LASSEN AMENDING TITLE 3 OF THE LASSEN COUNTY CODE PERTAINING TO TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR FEES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Lassen ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: The County of Lassen provides certain services to individuals and organizations that are considered extraordinary levels of service, or are services for which charges or other compensation are authorized pursuant to applicable laws.

SECTION 2: The County Treasurer-Tax Collector has calculated an average cost for providing services and determined that certain fees, rates and charges must be adjusted in an amount reasonably necessary to recover a portion of the County's cost of providing those services.

SECTION 3: The Board of Supervisors finds that it is in the public interest for the County to continue to provide these services, that the proposed fees, rates and charges represent the reasonable cost of providing those services, and that such fees, rates and charges comply with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Article XIII C of the California Constitution.

SECTION 4: Section 3.18.050 of the Lassen County Code pertaining to Treasurer-Tax Collector Fees shall be amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

3.18.050 Treasurer-Tax Collector Fees

The following fees, rates, and charges, enacted or raised pursuant to this section are in addition to any third party fees and vendor charges, including but not limited to, State or Federal fees:

DESCRIPTION	FEE
(a) Delinquent Cost on Second Installment of Current Secured Bills	\$20
(b) Cost of Noticing Secured Abstract Roll	\$75
(c) Installment Plan Fee	\$75
(d) Lot Line/Merger	\$50
(e) Segregation Fee	\$100

- (f) Non-sufficient Funds – Bad Check \$50
Fee

SECTION 5. All prior ordinances and resolutions which relate to the establishment and modification of fees charged by the County Treasurer Tax Collector shall remain in full force and effect to the extent not expressly revised herein.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The County Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its final adoption. It shall be published in the Lassen County Times, a newspaper of general circulation in Lassen County, in a manner according to law.
