Re: Range Increase for Specific Positions within Health and Social Services

Background: Lassen County's Health and Social Services (HSS) Agency has experienced a long-standing problem with the recruitment and retention of qualified individuals. In response, HSS conducted a salary market research analysis on the salaries of drivers, social workers and integrated caseworkers among similar size counties within our region. We found that the Lassen County pay schedule for these positions was less than the majority of the counties we surveyed.

Additionally, we need to resolve the discrepancy in what we currently pay our drivers with the new California minimum wage pay schedule. Beginning January 1, 2019, the minimum wage will increase to \$12.00 per hour, a wage that is higher than our current pay.

Therefore, we are proposing a one-range increase as follows:
