

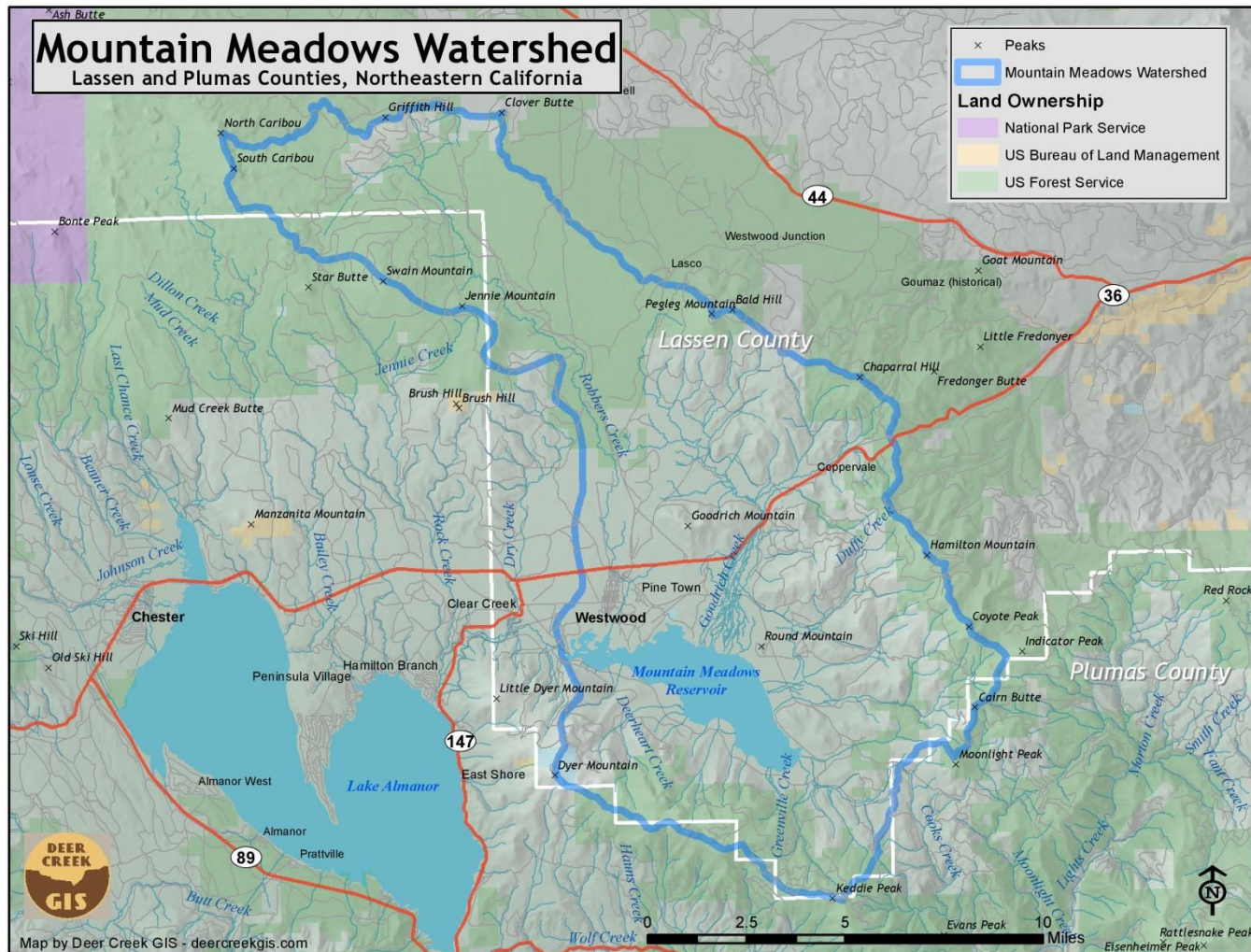
Mountain Meadows Conservancy

2018 Bass Planting in Walker Lake

- MMC received \$2,500 from PG&E to purchase 1000 young bass to begin the process of rebuilding the sport fishery
- We raised an additional \$2,500 from local supporters (Including \$300 from District 1 Supervisor) and purchased an additional 1000 bass
- Hope to plant additional bass in 2019

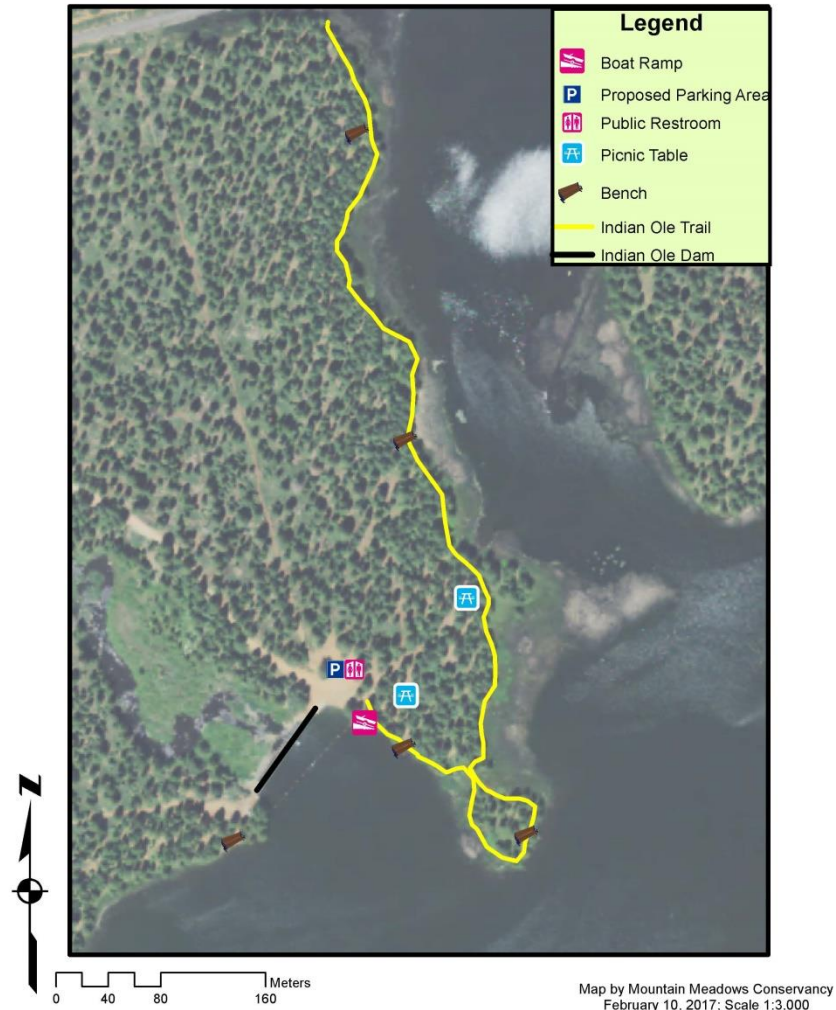

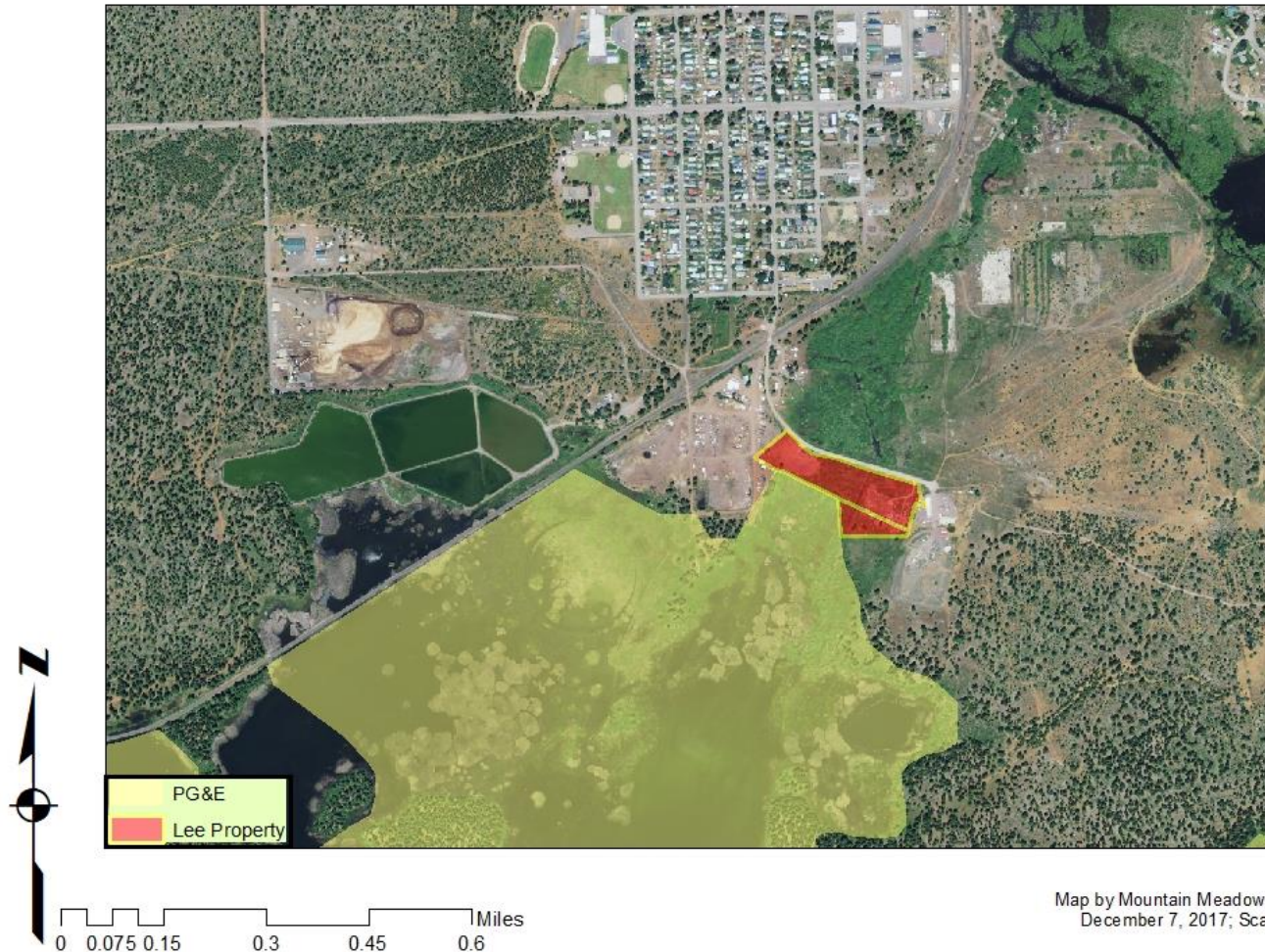
Indian Ole Dam Access Project
