Subject: Agreement between Lassen County and Disability Response for
Fiscal Year 2018/2019

Background:

Lassen County Health and Social Services in collaboration with other County Departments has identified a need for Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training. This contract will allow the following subjects to be covered:

- An overview of mental illness
- Mood and thought disorders
- Developmental and intellectual disabilities
- Excited delirium
- Mental illness and policing
- Current case law regarding contacts with mentally ill
- Suicide by cop
- Handling suicides in progress
- Writing better 5150 petitions
- Officer wellness and PTSD in law enforcement
- Elder suicide
- Veterans Cultural Competency (Combat to Community)
- De Escalation
- Communication

The initial training took place on November 12-14, 2018 and during this training, it was identified that there was a need to provide additional training. In order to provide additional training, we are asking for the Board of Supervisors to approve the attached contract.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no impact to County General Fund. The funding for this contract will be paid by the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Budget.

Action Requested:

1) Approve the Agreement; and 2) authorize the County Administrative Officer to execute.

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
LASSEN COUNTY
AND
DISABILITY RESPONSE**

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the COUNTY OF LASSEN, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and Disability Response, with a principal place of Business at West Sacramento, California, (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR").

This Agreement is made with reference to the following facts and circumstances:

WHEREAS, COUNTY has a need for Crisis Intervention Training; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR is qualified and experienced in providing such services;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the services to be rendered, the sums to be paid, and each and every covenant and condition contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. GENERAL.

CONTRACTOR shall provide service at the time and place and as specified within the context of this agreement, subject to direction by COUNTY through the Agreement administrator.

CONTRACTOR is an independent contractor and not an employee of COUNTY, and is not entitled to any benefits associated with COUNTY employment.

CONTRACTOR shall maintain Professional Liability insurance during the term of this Agreement in the amount of \$1,000,000 and shall provide a current Certificate of Insurance to COUNTY.

CONTRACTOR shall maintain in strict confidentiality the terms, conditions, and products of this Agreement and shall disclose such information only with the written authorization of COUNTY. Any disclosure in violation of this section shall be deemed a material breach of this Agreement.

2. SERVICES.

CONTRACTOR shall provide POST (Peace Officer Standards and Training) certified Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training. Subjects to be covered will include but are not limited to:

- An overview of mental illness
- Mood and thought disorders
- Developmental and intellectual disabilities
- Excited delirium
- Mental illness and policing
- Current case law regarding contacts with mentally ill
- Suicide by cop
- Handling suicides in progress
- Writing better 5150 petitions
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- Elder suicide
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- De Escalation
- Communication

CONTRACTOR shall provide all training materials

COUNTY will provide to CONTRACTOR:

- Space for training, including tables, chairs, presentation laptop, screen etc.

3. TERM.

The term of this Agreement shall be for the period November 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019.

Training shall be conducted on a mutually agreed upon date within the term of this agreement.

This Agreement is subject to termination at any time by either party.

4. PAYMENT.

COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR for services as follows:


5. DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES.


