IN HONOR OF

BILL ANDERSON

ON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE LASSEN COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT

Whereas, BILL ANDERSON began his employment as a temporary employee on June 12, 1995 working on the rock crusher and assisting with other projects. On November 30, 1999, he became a permanent employee with the Lassen County Public Works Department/Road Division as a Road Equipment Operator for Road District 1, Westwood area. In 2004, he transferred to Road District 3, Standish Area, as a Road Equipment Operator; on July 8, 2013, he was promoted to Senior Road Equipment Operator for Road District 3, a position he held until his retirement on December 28, 2018; and,

Whereas, BILL ANDERSON, has been assigned various duties and responsibilities within the Department; all of which he has performed and successfully completed. Bill is an experienced equipment operator and is especially known as being the County's pavement grinder operator; and,
