Discussion:

In the fall of 2018, the Lassen County Sheriff's Office applied for the Proposition 56 Tobacco Grant, which is managed by the California Department of Justice. Lassen County Sheriff's Office received an award of \$972,986 for a grant period of 32 months. The proposal included two Deputy Sheriff positions to serve as School Resource Officers and to conduct tobacco enforcement operations. It also included 1.5 FTE Community Services Officers who will conduct tobacco prevention and education programs in Lassen County schools, as well as tobacco retailer education and diversion programs.

The Lassen County Sheriff's Office has drafted a proposed budget for the remainder of the 2018/2019 fiscal year, with a total appropriation of \$132,494. These funds will support the positions identified in the original proposal, along with operational expenses and administrative costs.

Fiscal Impact:

No General Fund Impact.

Recommendation:

That the Lassen County Board of Supervisors approve the following actions:

- 1. Create a new fund and budget unit for the Proposition 56 Tobacco Grant.
- 2. Authorize additional positions to include: two Deputy Sheriff Positions, and 1.5 FTE Community Services Officer positions.
- 3. Adopt the proposed budget with an appropriation of \$132,494.
