Lassen County Election Division – Registrar of Voters Request for Budget Increase 2018/2019

On November 13th, 2018, Lassen Community College District Board of Trustees, passed Resolution No. 2018.11.13-6.01, ordering the Lassen County Registrar of Voters to conduct a Special Election, to elect two board members from Trustee Area 1. This was due to an error on the November 5, 2018, General Election Ballot. This was legally required by the Secretary of State who invalidated this race.

On January 16, 2019, California Governor Gavin Newsom, proclaimed a Special Election to be held on June 4, 2019, to replace Senator Ted Gaines, who left Senate District 1 to pursue the Board of Equalization position. The *Primary Election* was mandated to be held on March 26, 2019, preceding the day of the *Special General Election* at which the vacancy is to be filled. **If one candidate receives a majority of the votes (50% + 1), no election will be needed on June 4, 2019.** However, if Brian Dahle wins the Senate seat, he will vacate his Assembly seat and there will be another special election mandated in the next fiscal year.

The current budget status of the Election Division Fund/Budget Unit #100-0392, indicates a **negative balance of -\$1,323** in the Services and Supplies Major Object. This negative amount will increase by the end of the Fiscal Year because of committed funds.

Senate Bill 216 (SB216) was signed into law and took effect on January 1, 2019, changing **Elections Code 3010** and requiring us to provide an envelope with **prepaid postage for the return of the vote by mail ballot**. To perform this service, we are using the existing Business Return Mail (BRM) account at the United States Postal Service (USPS). Funds must be deposited into this account to cover the cost of postage. When ballots are mailed back to the Clerk's office, the postage fee for each ballot is reduced from the balance. The cost of a returned ballot is \$0.55 plus \$0.83 per piece handling charge. This results in a cost of \$1.38 per returned ballot.

The Salaries and Wages Major Object for the Election Division fund is indicating a savings, due to the delay in the hiring the Administrative Assistant-Elections in the beginning of the fiscal year. \$6,000 of this anticipated savings was utilize to make a deposit into the BRM account at the USPS to be used for the March 26, 2019, Senate District 1, Special Primary Election.

To estimate the amount of postage needed, I calculated the voter turnout from the past four elections. It is anticipated that during the March and June Elections approximately 6,000 ballots should be returned at a cost of \$8,280. Because the May election is a Vote-by-Mail Election, we are anticipating a turnout of approximately 8,000 voters at a cost of \$11,040.

We have been working diligently to cut costs everywhere possible. Due to time limits and cost, the Sample Ballots were printed as loose leaf copies and inserted with the Official Ballot before mailing, saving us approximately \$10,000. Unfortunately, it created a great deal of confusion with the voters because it was not mailed separately in booklet form.

We also received a great deal of help from our IT department enabling us to create the Audio in house for our Touch Screen voting units. This resulted in a savings of over \$300.

Because the May 7, 2019, Election is Vote-By-mail, we will be saving over \$7,000 in poll worker pay and rental fees; approximately \$1300 in polling supplies; and over \$1000 for Election Night overtime.

A low voter turnout at the polling places is anticipated during the March and June Elections, so we have reduced the number of workers at each precinct to save money.

The State currently does not pay for elections but California State Association of Counties (CSAC), Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC) and Urban Counties of California, are requesting the Department of Finance to reimburse counties for the cost of conducting special elections for legislative vacancies. I have also included an estimated cost survey they conducted.

The college will be billed for their portion of the cost for the May Election, but the exact cost is unknown and will be determined after the election and all the bills are received.

In working with the County Administration Office it was decided that the funds should be transferred from Special Reserve, Appropriation for Contingency (fund 101-1101) to the General Fund in the amount of \$121,410 and increase General Fund, Elections (fund 100-0392) in the amount of \$121,410. A 4/5 vote is required to make this transfer.

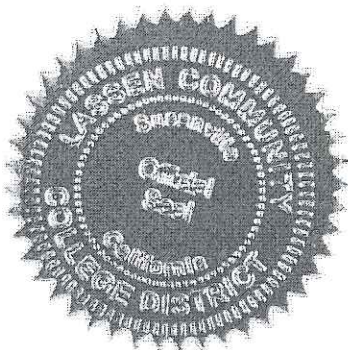

DIVISION 3. VOTE BY MAIL VOTING, NEW RESIDENT, AND NEW CITIZEN VOTING [3000 - 3503] *(Heading of Division 3 amended by Stats. 2007, Ch. 508, Sec. 10.)*

CHAPTER 1. Vote by Mail Application and Voting Procedures [3000 - 3026] *(Heading of Chapter 1 amended by Stats. 2007, Ch. 508, Sec. 11.)*

3010.

(a) The elections official shall deliver all of the following to each qualified applicant:

(1) The ballot for the precinct in which the voter resides. In primary elections, this shall also be accompanied by the ballot for the central committee of the party for which the voter has disclosed a preference, if any.

(2) All supplies necessary for the use and return of the ballot, including an identification envelope with prepaid postage for the return of the vote by mail ballot.

(b) An officer of this state shall not make a charge for services rendered to a voter under this chapter.

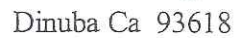

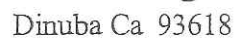

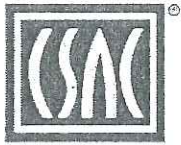

Dear Ms. Bosler,

On behalf of our three organizations, we write to request the Department of Finance reimburse counties for the costs of conducting special elections for legislative vacancies.

For many years, special elections for legislative vacancies were reimbursed by the state, even through difficult deficit years. However, these payments stopped in 2007 and have yet to resume, leaving counties to foot the bill for millions of dollars' worth of state elections.

All other local government agencies — cities, special districts, and schools — pay for their portion of elections. When legislative elections are part of a regular primary or general election ballot, counties pay the state's share of the costs, which in these cases are both marginal and predictable. However, for special legislative vacancies, a county must mobilize its entire election infrastructure, resulting in significantly higher, unbudgeted costs.

Already in 2019, the Governor has declared two special elections for Senate District 1, affecting eleven counties, mostly rural, and Senate District 33 in Los Angeles County. And in 2018, three southern California counties administered special elections for Senate District 32, Assembly District 54, Assembly District 45, and Assembly District 39. The estimated costs of all of these elections are detailed in the enclosed document.

For these reasons, we respectfully ask that the state reimburse counties for the cost of special legislative vacancy elections in the current and previous fiscal years. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have questions or would like to discuss the issue. Thank you for your consideration.
