Officer (CAO) to Execute the Agreement

### **Background:**

Each year the County applies on behalf of the Environmental Health Department as the LEA for a grant from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to support the local Integrated Waste Management Program for the County's waste facilities and inspection programs.

Before the County may apply, the Board of Supervisors must pass a Resolution authorizing submission of the grant application and the CAO to sign all related documents on behalf of the County. This Resolution may be approved for period of one to five years. The last Resolution was adopted in 2015 for three years. This year the department is requesting that the Resolution be adopted for five year period beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2024 as a means of reducing the administrative burden required.

#### **Fiscal Impact:**

There is no impact to County General Fund. The LEA Grant brings revenues to the Environmental Health Department.

#### **Action Requested:**

Adopt the attached Resolution and authorize the CAO to execute the application and all related documents.

## RESOLUTION FOR LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY GRANTS

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various Grant Programs in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lassen County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for all grants for which the County of Lassen is eligible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the County of Lassen all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution
