## RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Approve an Agreement with ECORP Consulting, Inc. to perform an environmental assessment for the future construction of Fredonyer Butte trails; 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to sign.

#### DISCUSSION:

For the past several years a conceptual project known as the Fredonyer Butte Trail System, located approximately 10 miles west of Susanville, has been discussed among interested parties, including the Lassen National Forest, Lassen Land and Trails Trust, Susanville Area Bicycle Association, Volcanic Legacy Community Partnership and the County.

Previously at the Board meeting on August 8, 2017 (BOS letter and minutes attached) the Board approved submitting a Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) program application for funding and a support letter for the funding application to the Lassen National Forest. Subsequently the application for funding was submitted and a grant was awarded (BOS letter attached) in May 2018 in the amount of \$80,000 to complete the needed environmental work for the project.

A Request for Proposals was released September 6, 2018 and one proposal was received from ECORP Consulting Inc. The cost for services of the proposal exceeded project budget so discussions were held among the project participants (Consultant, Lassen National Forest Service, County) to discuss options to bring service costs within available budget. The Lassen National Forest Service clarified specific project details and conducted additional environmental work originally expected to be completed by the consultant. This allowed the consultant to submit a revised cost proposal under project budget. All parties are ready to move forward with the project.

That the Board provide direction to staff, concerning the Fredonyer Butte Trails System Project Concept, for several items: 1) Submittal of Resource Advisory Committee funding request; 2) Entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Lassen National Forest and other interested partners to undertake project; 3) Enter into "Challenge Cost Share Agreement" with Lassen National Forest and other interested partners to undertake project. 4) Provide letter of support for Resource Advisory Committee (RAC).

#### **DISCUSSION:**

For the past several years a conceptual project known as the Fredonyer Butte Trail System, located approximately 10 miles west of Susanville, has been discussed among interested parties, including the Lassen National Forest, Lassen Land and Trails Trust, Susanville Area Bicycle Association and the County.

Preliminary work completed to date includes a physically flagged trail corridor and a GIS data base map of trail corridor. The next step in going forward with the concept will require environmental clearance of the trail system by the Lassen National Forest. To move from the conceptual discussion to a formal project will require clearly defining the project and an environmental review. In that effort, a MOU defining benefit and interests, by participating parties, will be required. An accessory document to the MOU also required, is a "Challenge Cost Share Agreement", which defines and allows for the expenditure of funds on the project.

A possible funding source to undertake the needed environmental work has been identified. The Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) program, administered by the Lassen National Forest, has eligible funding available that the County may apply for on behalf of the interested parties.
