Resolution establishing Pledge of Revenue for Financial Assurance on the Standish Pit, CA Mine ID#

91-18-0030, in the amount of \$500,000.

<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> That the Board of Supervisor's approve Resolution No. 20-____, "Resolution Establishing Pledge of Revenue For Standish Pit (CA MINE ID #91-18-0030) To Satisfy Requirements Of Section 2773.1 Public Resources Code For Financial Assurance To Reclaim Open Pit Mines."

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Road Department has obtained Use Permit #96-006 for the operation of an open pit mine, Standish Pit, CA Mine 91-18-0030, located on Standish Pit Road off Lake Leavitt near Standish, California.

The existing Pledge of Revenue for this site needs to be revised to reflect the recently approved cost estimate, in the amount of \$455,209.73, for the 2019 Financial Assurance Cost Estimate (FACE). The current Pledge of Revenue can be greatly reduced since the site has been converted to a stockpile area and is in the process of being closed.

It is recommended that the current required Pledge of Revenue for the Standish Pit be increased by approximately 10% to \$500,000 to provide some capacity for minor changes in future Financial Assurances Cost Estimates.

The attached Resolution replaces the current Pledge of Revenue for the Standish Pit, Resolution 09- 049 approved on September 8, 2009 in the amount of \$948,421.91. Overall decrease of approximately \$448,000.

<u>ALTERNATIVES</u>: Do not approve financial assurance.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPACT</u>: A Pledge of Revenue from the Road Fund 122 for financial assurance for the reclamation plan on the Standish Pit in the amount of \$500,000.00.

RESOLUTION NO. 20 -

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PLEDGE OF REVENUE FOR THE STANDISH PIT (CA MINE ID# 91-18-0030) TO SATISFY REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 2773.1 PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE FOR FINANCIAL ASSURANCE TO RECLAIM OPEN PIT MINES

WHEREAS, Lassen County Department of Public Works (Road Division) operates an open pit mine known as the Standish Pit; and

WHEREAS, Lassen County has control of a portion of State Gas Tax and Forest Reserve Funds for road purposes, known as the Road Fund, which is a separate budget account from the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Lassen County Community Development Department as Lead Agency approved Use Permit #96-006, Reclamation Plan and 2019 Financial Assurance of \$455,209.73 for the operations at the Standish Pit.

WHEREAS, Lassen County Department of Public Works (Road Division) recommends that the current required Pledge of Revenue be increased by approximately 10% to \$500,000 to provide some capacity for minor changes in future Financial Assurance Cost Estimates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lassen County Board of Supervisors, State of California that \$500,000 of the Road Fund be used as a Pledge of Revenue for the above stated purpose, to be renewed each fiscal year and adjusted annually, if necessary, to a minimum equal the current approved Financial Assurance Cost Estimate (FACE), which will be prepared annually, in accordance with the requirements of the Surface Mining and Reclamation Act (SMARA).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pledge of Revenue shall remain in place until release has been approved by written consent and authorized signatures of both the lead agency (Lassen County) and the Department of Conservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Lassen County Department of Public Works (Road Division) ceases at any time to retain control of its ability to allocate any pledged revenue to conduct and complete reclamation, the Department shall notify the lead agency and the Department of Conservation and shall obtain alternative coverage within 60 days after control lapses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by this resolution which authorizes the lead agency or the Department of Conservation to use the proceeds of said pledge to conduct and complete reclamation as the lead agency or the Department of Conservation determines the operator is incapable of performing (pursuant to California Public Resources Code § 2773.1).
