# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LASSEN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA ESTABLISHING THE LASSEN COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lassen authorized the merger of the former Mental Health Department and the former Alcohol and Other Drugs Department into a single department known as the Lassen County Behavioral Health Department effective July 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, California State Welfare and Institutions Code § 5604 in part requires each community mental health service to have a mental health board; and

WHEREAS, California State Alcohol and Drug Program Certification Standards § 18015 no longer requires but strongly recommends each county have a drug and alcohol advisory board; and

WHEREAS, the Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the County to establish an advisory board that meets the requirement for a mental health board as well as the need for a substance use advisory board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lassen County Board of Supervisors does hereby formally establish the Lassen County Behavioral Health Advisory Board effective July 1, 2013, with the following purpose and operating policies:

- A. Name Lassen County Behavioral Health Advisory Board
- B. Purpose To serve in an advisory capacity to the Behavioral Health Department and the Board of Supervisors with regard to mental health, substance use disorder, and co-occurring disorder treatment services and programs.
- Membership
   Seven to eleven members, recommended by the advisory board and appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
  - All members shall be registered to vote in Lassen County and shall serve at the will of the Board of Supervisors.
  - Members of the former Mental Health and Drug and Alcohol Advisory Boards shall be given priority consideration for membership.
- D. Board Category 1: Four to six consumers of behavioral health services, or their immediate family members, with a balance between mental health and substance use disorder representation.

  Category 2: One County Supervisor.

<u>Category 3</u>: Remaining members shall be from the general public representing education, law and justice, health care, and/or human services community partners.
