The applicants are proposing a 1,800-square-foot single-family residence that deviates from the roof pitch and roof overhang requirements of Lassen County Code § 18.108.235. Deviation from these requirements is allowed upon approval by the Architectural Review Committee through the Design Review process. The project site is zoned A-2-B-2 (Agricultural Residential District, 2-Acre Building Site Combining District) and its land use designation is "Rural Residential" in the *Janesville Planning Area*, 1993, and the *Lassen County General Plan*, 2000.
