Discussion:

Four Lassen County Sheriff's Office employees are scheduled to attend a Safety One Snowcat Operator and winter survival training. This course consists of four days of instruction with hands on instruction operating the Piston Bully Snowcat the Lassen County Sheriff's acquired in 2020. At the completion of the course, a Snowcat operator certification will be granted. The coursework will be held in Auburn and the operator training will be held in Yuba Gap.

We have reserved two seats for the February 1-4, 2021 course and two seats for the March 1-4, 2021. The up-front training costs will exceed \$2000 and require advance Board Authorization pursuant to the Lassen County Travel Policy. The cost of training will be paid for out of TITLE 3

The training costs are as follows:



WHAT TO BRING TO CLASS

Each student must supply their own snowcat for class.

We ask our students to bring the same gear that they would normally take on any snowcat trip or other outdoor winter adventure, so that they are prepared to safely and comfortably work in contact with wet snow, high winds, and ice. While class is always expected to end on time, it is entirely possible for unforeseen situations to delay the end of the day until after sundown, and low light situations may be unavoidable. Class will continue rain, snow, shine, or wind, and students should be prepared to spend time outside in any combination of these elements.

While all effort is made to consider physical and medical limitations and provide for the safest training possible, there are physical elements of this class that will result in interaction with wet snow for potentially prolonged periods of time. Students should arrive physically and mentally prepared for such conditions. It is the responsibility of individual students to convey physical or medical concerns to the lead instructor and determine their own limitations. Instructors will respect these concerns but cannot make the determination for the student.

In an effort to prepare students for class, we recommend they bring the following items:

- Layered Cold Weather Clothing We recommend a windproof/waterproof outer shell such as Gortex, with enough variety of inner layers to adjust to the temperatures of a heated snowcat as well as the outdoor weather expected that day.
 - We strongly recommend avoiding cotton clothing, such as denim jeans/cotton Carhartt style gear.
 - We advise against one-piece snow suits, as adjusting to weather changes throughout the day is not practical.
- **Head Protection** Please bring at least one warm hat to wear. Options for thickness as well as redundancy are a good idea as well.
- Gloves Warm gloves will be necessary for this class. Contact with snow and other wet/cold components is a guarantee. Please bring at least two pairs of gloves, as one pair will likely become wet and ineffective. The best gloves will be insulated and water resistant.
- **Boots** Insulated and water-resistant boots are required for this class. Uninsulated leather work boots or steel-toe boots are not sufficient for the weather condition of most classes.
- **Eye Protection** Sunglasses are necessary for daytime driving, even in cloudy conditions. We also recommend glasses for low-visibility conditions as well if you have them available. Typically yellow or pink lenses work well in these conditions and still provide UV protection.
- Sun Protection Sunblock is a good idea for any exposed skin in the snow. UV light is often reflected up from the snow, which subjects the body to increased chance of sunburn, even in areas that are not typically a concern, such as underneath your chin and arms.
- Tools If you are driving to class, please bring any tools that you might find useful on a snowcat trip. This could include:
 - Shovels for digging snow survival shelters and helping free a stuck snowcat.
 - Tarps for something to lay on during repairs and to aid in snow survival shelters.
 - Any other repair or survival tools you think might be useful.

If you do not have this equipment available to you, we recommend making the minimum purchases necessary to be comfortable during class. You may wish to reserve large purchases for after the class, as clothing and equipment will be covered in much greater detail during the classroom portion.

If you need new equipment, use the code SNOW20 at S1 Supply: <u>proshop.safetyoneinc.com</u>. We offer a 10% discount to all trainees during the time frame of your training period.

This brief guidance is provided to assist students who do not work in the snow on a regular basis, to make this training a safe and comfortable experience. This is not designed to cover the topics of proper gear selection, which we will save for when we see you in class!
