#### PUBLIC COMMENTS

<u>United Public Employees of California (UPEC) Labor Relation Representative</u> <u>Barbara Ramey</u>: Thanked the Board for the recent negotiations and efforts on behalf of the Lassen County employees.

## UNAGENDIZED REPORTS BY BOARD MEMBERS

Supervisor Hemphill: 1) Had questions for the United States Forest Service (USFS). Requested a letter to be sent pertaining to fire breaks; 2) stated California set a presidence on ground water districts in Scotts Valley and paid growers to stop pumping. Requested the issue to be addressed. Supervisor Bridges: 1) Attended a Northern Rural Training and Employment Consortium (NoRTEC) meeting; 2) will be attending a Big Valley Advisory Groundwater Committee (BVAC) meeting. Supervisor Gallagher: 1) Stated the Presidential Declaration for the fire was completed; 2) encouraged community members that were unemployed or businesses that had to close due to the fire to seek funding through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); 3) continues to be disappointed in Plumas National Forest regarding their lack of fire response with the Dixie Fire. Supervisor Albaugh: 1) Will be attending a BVAC meeting. Commended the Lassen and Modoc County staff for preparing all the draft chapters; 2) requested a name change for Fish and Game to Fish and Predators; 3) reminded everyone to vote on September 14, 2021; 4) attended a Rural County Representatives of

California (RCRC) meeting; 5) attended a Sierra Nevada Conservancy meeting;

6) thanked Sheriff/Coroner Dean Growdon for allowing Captain McGarva for taking Supervisor Gallagher on a tour of Greenville, Ca.; 7) briefly discussed water rights in Sacramento and San Joaquin drainage; 8) requested from staff to put together a proclamation to send to Chris Carlton in the Plumas National Forest for successfully burning an entire national forest. Close to \$1,000,000,000 in costs.
