**Title:** PLANNING  
SUBJECT: Proposed amendment to Title 18 of the Lassen County Code to add sections 18.14.762 "Medical helipad" and 18.102.030(e) "Selected District Uses." This amendment would allow for the placement of medical helipads, subject to securing a use permit, in all zoning districts except for residential districts as defined in Lassen County Code Section 18.14.995, and medical helipads shall not be permitted in "P-C" Planned Community Districts, "O-S" Open Space Districts, "O-D" Primitive Area Districts, "O-H" Historical Site Districts, "O-C-B" Public Campground/Boating/Beach Districts, "T-P-Z" Timber Production Zone Districts, or "A-P" Agricultural Preserve Combining Districts. This Ordinance was introduced at the Board of Supervisors meeting on August 22, 2017.
