SUBJECT: Consider Certification of a Subsequent Environmental Impact Report and approval a proposed project to amend mining operations at the Ward Lake Pit (CA mine ID #91-18-0008). If approved, the amendment would allow for 24-hour mining operations Monday through Saturday (currently 6:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday through Saturday), extend the life of the mine from 2020 to 2030, and allow site production in excess of the permitted 100,000 tons during declared emergencies. (File EIR #2018-001, UP #2018-003 and RP #2018-001). FISCAL IMPACT: None.
